175th ANNIVERSARY OF THE SOLEMN OPENING OF ST JOSEPH'S CHURCH: The church was solemnly opened at a Mass celebrated by Bishop John Murdoch, Vicar Apostolic of the Western District, on Sunday 13th June 1847.

- I tin of vegetables
- I tin of beans
- I carton of long-life milk (UHT)
- I tin of hotdog sausages
- I tin of sardines/mackerel fillets/tuna
- I packet of biscuits
- I toilet roll
- I bar of soap.

Please ensure canned foods have a ring pull for opening. Please also note that tea, coffee and sugar are not required.
