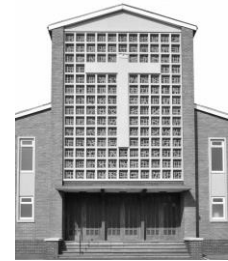

The Walled Garden

Maybe you see your inner world like a garden. A favourite place of mine is an island off the north east coast of Britain. The first thing you would notice, if you landed on this or any other island, would be the harbour and the beaches fringing the island's coastline. If you had the time to explore it more deeply, you would find the fields and forests further in land, where the islanders grow crops and cultivate trees and keep animals. On my island there is also a small but lovely castle with a tiny walled garden close by, which is only accessible at certain times, when the gardener is in attendance. The garden is lovingly tended and blooms with a variety of herbs and blossoms. It was originally planted by owners of the castle, who wanted it to be a special place which would express their own special delight in life and be themselves, away from their public image.

I find a parable of my own inner peace here on this island. I find aspects of myself that I might call the harbours and landing stages of my life within the human family. These are places where I meet people and let them into my life – or keep them out! I find an outer fringe – my beaches, where I am in direct contact with the turbulent, demanding, unpredictable world. Then I move inland where I discover the 'what' and 'how' of my existence. What is my work about? What crop am I growing? What is my contribution to the day to day living of the human race? What am I best at? What am I bad at? Where are the wild overgrown areas of my life and where are my fields in better order? In what part of my island do I feel most at home and comfortable? Where do I feel threatened?

Then we come to the walled garden. It is my innermost space where I meet God and to which only a few hearts have access. What grows in that garden? God has planted it for his own delight, and for mine, and ultimately for the delight of all who dwell in the Kingdom. When I spend time in that walled garden, I am being invited to discover just who God thinks I am!
