GALLOWAY DIOCESAN CHOIR: The Diocesan Choir is looking to recruit new members who enjoy singing as part of a group and are committed to the enhancement of the liturgy through music. This four-part choir has been in existence in its present form for 23 years. They lead the music at diocesan events at least two times a year, and the rehearsal period runs from September to March (with a break in December/January). Rehearsals take place in St Margaret's Cathedral, Ayr on Wednesday evenings from 7.15 pm until about 8.45 pm. The first rehearsal of the new season is on Wednesday 20th September at 7.15 pm. When a new bishop is appointed to Galloway Diocese it will be the task of the choir to support the singing at the bishop's ordination Mass. DOORS OPEN DAY: Doors Open Day takes place each year in September and encourages people to visit buildings of historical and social interest and learn about them. St Joseph's Church will be part of the Ayrshire Doors Open Day programme 2023 which is a prestigious opportunity to showcase our building and parish. NATIONAL PILGRIMAGE TO CARFIN: The National Pilgrimage to Scotland's Marian Shrine will take place on Sunday 3rd September with Mass at 3 pm. At this Mass the bishops, priests and people of Scotland will pray for peace in our world, particularly in Ukraine. Bishop Kenneth Nowakowski of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of the Holy Family in the UK will preach at the Mass, and the Choir of the Ukrainian Catholic Community in Scotland will participate in the Mass along with the Motherwell Diocesan Choir. A bus will run from St Joseph's Church, Kilmarnock leaving at 1 pm, returning around 6.00 pm. You will be in Carfin for the Mass at 3.00 pm. No catering is available so please take a packed lunch. Cost £10 to be paid on the day, under 16s free. Given the particular need for peace in our world at this time I would encourage as many as possible to take part.
